SUBJECT: Storm Bret Warning, Advisory #1

Dear Visitor,

With Bret approaching, a Storm Warning has been issued for Saint Lucia. This indicates the possibility of experiencing storm conditions within the next 24 hours. Our territory's emergency management agency has been working diligently to ensure the safety of everyone in our destination.

Effective 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, June 22, 2023, the George F.L. Charles Airport (SLU) and Hewanorra International Airport (UVF) will be closed until further notice. All seaports will cease operation at 1:00 p.m. This closure is in place to prioritize the safety and well-being of all individuals.

Thus far, service providers LIAT, Air Antilles, and interCaribbean have canceled all flight operations for Thursday, June 22, 2023. We understand that this situation may impact the travel plans of individuals. We urge you to contact your airline or ferry service to reschedule your trip.

Visitors staying in an Airbnb, VRBO, or similar accommodations are encouraged to contact Saint Lucia Tourism Authority at information@stlucia.org to provide their contact information, the address where they are staying, and an off-island emergency contact number.

We urge everyone to stay indoors and away from glass windows when tropical storm-force winds are affecting the area. It is important to avoid entering the ocean as well. Failure to comply with this request puts human lives at risk, including yours and our first responders.
