#### **DESTINATION UPDATE**

September 2023



Saint Lucia, a mango-shaped island, is only 27 miles long and 14 miles wide but offers something for everyone. It's truly nature's paradise, home to the famous Piton mountains and a lush rainforest fringed by golden sandy beaches. You can spend your days enjoying hiking trails, the volcanic mud baths and swimming in the warm Caribbean Sea. It's a bird-spotting haven too with five endemic bird species, one of which is the island's national bird, the Saint Lucia Parrot. Many visitors go snorkelling to discover the stunning marine life and coral and Saint Lucia is also home to 22 dive sites so there is plenty to explore beneath the water.

While Saint Lucia's natural assets are its best feature, a big part of the island's charm lies with its rich cultural heritage and its people. Two of the signature events which celebrate this are the Jazz & Arts Festival and Saint Lucia Carnival. With more than



10,000 festival goers attending each of the main five days of Jazz and approximately 9,000 international visitors purchasing tickets to the events it was a huge success in 2023. The next event, although it has been around many years was Carnival, with in excess of 10,000 visitors from all over the world joining in this year's festivities.

Whatever you choose to do, you'll be warmly greeted as you explore Saint Lucia and enjoy the genuine hospitality.

Sustainable and regenerative tourism continues to be integral when welcoming visitors to Saint Lucia. Without it, all those attractions that people come to Saint Lucia for, would disappear. Initiatives to foster sustainability are top of the list of Saint Lucia's priorities to effectively manage the impact. Hotels are an integral part of sustainability with results-driven programmes (many actively involve visitors in conservation) that reduce thousands of tons of waste, conserve energy and eradicate invasive species. In the past two years, even more hotels have committed to reducing their environmental impact.

It continues to be a challenging time for most of the UK and beyond due to the cost of living issues, but with the support of our trade and media partners alongside the success of events such as Jazz, Carnival, Cricket and ARC, our tourism numbers are performing well. As of the end of July we have welcomed 234,424 visitors, up 12% on 2022.

- The US continues to lead the markets with 130,986 year to date, approximately 55% of the total visitor numbers
- The UK had a strong start to the year but the summer has seen a dip in visitor figures compared to 2022 with a 6.4% drop.
- Canada is coming back strongly from 2022, with current figures more than double those of last year, benefitting from regular air access.

As we approach the key winter season for 2023, we look ahead to the next 12 months with a preview of our latest news and events to look out for.

#### **NEW DEVELOPMENTS**

- The Dream Hotel Group announced that the new 96-key Cas en Bas Beach Resort will open in Cap Estate in the north, in 2023.
- Sandals Halcyon Beach Resort will debut 25 new suites in February 2023. In addition, 20 Rondoval suites, are planned for Sandals Regency La Toc next year.
- Saint James Club Morgan Bay will rebrand as an upscale all-inclusive Secrets property in late 2024 making it the second AMR property on the island.
- The Cabot Saint Lucia development had the soft launch of their Coore and Crenshaw golf course on July 20, 2023. The project is scheduled to be completed by 2025/2026.



## **AWARD-WINNING DESTINATION**

The World Travel Awards has named Saint Lucia as the 'Caribbean's Leading Honeymoon Destination' for the fourteenth time, while also clinching the title of 'Caribbean's Leading Adventure Tourism Destination' for the second time. The pinnacle of this year's success was the coveted title of 'Caribbean's Leading Nature Destination', a maiden recognition that underscores Saint Lucia's unwavering commitment to preserving its natural treasures.

Regarded as the industry's equivalent of the Oscars, the World Travel Awards is a globally acclaimed platform that celebrates excellence across the travel, tourism, and hospitality sectors. Since its inception in 1993, the awards have embraced a wide spectrum of categories, encompassing destinations, hotels, airlines, cruise lines, tour operators, and travel agencies.

#### **SAINT LUCIA ON TV**

Saint Lucia is set to star in a new travel programme called 'Fantastic Friends'. The new TV show, produced by Dash Pictures, is hosted by sibling actors James and Oliver Phelps, who portrayed the Weasley twins in the Harry Potter films. The six-part travel series sees James and Oliver travel the world to explore different destinations, starting with Saint Lucia. In each episode they meet a famous friend and together they discover new landscapes, cultures and take part in some fun challenges along the way. In Saint Lucia, the first episode, they meet actress Maisie Williams (Arya Stark in Game of Thrones). Adventure is at the heart of their visit as they zipline through the rainforest, hike mountains and try out jungle biking. It's currently on screens in the US on the CW Network and is due to air in the UK later this year. More details to be announced.





#### **THREE PEAKS CHALLENGE**

Saint Lucia has three iconic mountains: Gros Piton, Petit Piton and Mount Gimie. Gros Piton is already a popular hike with visitors and locals already. A new adventure experience has now been launched, bringing together all three climbs. The Saint Lucia Three Peaks Challenge invites visitors to climb each one during their stay. Local experts and guides from The 758 Adventurers provide an escorted series of the three hikes which can be booked across the duration of your visit.

# **DIVEFEST (September 8 - 14 2023, annually)**

Saint Lucia is one of the most scenic islands in the Caribbean with 22 world-class dive sites and more snorkelling just off shore. There is endless beauty beneath the surface with rainbow colour reefs and abundant marine life. This September, Saint Lucia hosts its third annual Dive Fest with a week of special activities to showcase the diving experience.

# **ROMANCE SUMMIT (October 4 to 9)**



'Say Yes to Saint Lucia' is a Global Romance Summit later this year, enabling agents to meet key partners, including villas, hotels and wedding planners. There will also be keynote speakers, a bridalwear fashion show and a digital media strategy workshop. The SLTA is taking a small group of UK trade to experience the summit for themselves.

#### **CREOLE HERITAGE MONTH (October annually)**

October is Creole Heritage Month in Saint Lucia and an opportunity to celebrate the French Creole language and culture across communities around the island. The celebration takes the form of musical, theatrical and other performances, seminars and lectures, a variety of culinary experiences, street parties and art exhibitions. It culminates on the weekend of October 29th with the celebration of International Creole Day (Jounen Kwéyòl) in various communities throughout the island.



The theme for this year's celebration 'Kwéyòl: Wasin Pèp-la' is translated to 'Creole, the root of the people' speaks to the integral role of creole culture in shaping the history and identity of Saint Lucian people.

#### LA MARGUERITE FLOWER FESTIVAL (October 17 2023, annually)

Many Saint Lucians observe the day of Fete La Marguerite. This is the second of the two flower festivals held annually. La Marguerite members dress in the colour purple and create displays of the Marguerite flower in addition to singing their traditional songs.

#### <u>ATLANTIC RALLY CRUISE (ARC - November-December 2023, annually)</u>

The ARC is a 'must do' for many sailors, and attracts over 200 boats and 1200 people every year to sail 2700 NM across the Atlantic from Gran Canaria to Saint Lucia. The 2023 edition of the Atlantic Rally for Cruisers will start from Las Palmas on 19 November 2023, following the traditional programme of pre-departure activities from 6 November 2023. The fleet will arrive in Saint Lucia to be met on the dock with a rum punch and a chilled beer after the adventure of a lifetime and the final prize giving will be held in Rodney Bay on 16 December.

# SAINT LUCIA JAZZ AND ARTS FESTIVAL 2024 (April 30 - May 12 2024, annually)

Saint Lucia successfully welcomed back the renowned Saint Lucia Jazz & Arts Festival in 2023. This highly anticipated event returned after a three-year hiatus and captivated global audiences. Set against the picturesque backdrop of Pigeon Island national park, the festival showcased a diverse programme featuring world-renowned musicians, artists, and performers.

Genres included Afro beats, pure jazz, pop, Kingdom gospel, Soca, reggae, Zouk, Caribbean fusion and world beats. On the final evening, 'The Ultimate Celebration'

#### SAINT LUCIA CARNIVAL (July 1-16 2024, annually)

Heralded as one of the best carnivals in the Caribbean, the Saint Lucia Carnival returned in 2022 after a two-year break due to the Pandemic and will take place in July 2024. The celebrations include a variety of competitions such as the Power and Groovy Monarch, Senior and Junior Panoramas (Steel Pan Competitions), and the Inter-Commercial House Calypso competition, dozens of community events, and of course a continuous calendar of parties and fetes. The season culminates in an exciting, fun-filled two-day street parade of live bands and DJ music.

#### LA ROSE FLOWER FESTIVAL (August 30 2023 annually)

This cultural event is one of the two Flower Festivals – "La Rose" and "La Marguerite" held annually in observance of Saint Lucia's rich cultural memory, history and heritage. These two flower festivals depict a historical rivalry among communities whose members sing the virtues of their flowers. "La Rose" members pledge their allegiance to the rose by dressing in red and creating flamboyant displays made of roses.

#### **AIR ACCESS**

Direct and frequent flights from London to Saint Lucia provide year-round easy access by air. British Airways and TUI have year-round flights. British Airways offers daily, direct flights from London Gatwick whilst the weekly TUI flight (also from Gatwick) departs every Tuesday.

Virgin Atlantic returns to Saint Lucia for the winter season operating three direct flights a week (Monday, Wednesday and Friday) from London Heathrow. The seasonal service starts on 17th November 2023 to 12th May 2023.


